

NEVADA INSURANCE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

REQUIRED HOURS

Licensed producers in Nevada are required to take 30 hours of CE, including 3 hours of ethics, every 3-year license term. The Producer will be required to renew the first day of the month following the license issue date, every 3 years. No carry over credits are allowed and a student cannot take a course more than once in a 3-year license term.

CATEGORY RESTRICTIONS

Students may only take an approved course in the line of authority held to obtain their Continuing Education credits.

SPECIAL TRAINING

- LONG TERM CARE PARTNERSHIP TRAINING Before a Producer can sell or solicit Long Term Care Insurance they must complete an initial, state approved, 8-hour Long Term Care Training course. Producers must then complete a 4-hour ongoing training requirement every 24 months following the initial date of completion.
- FLOOD INSURANCE TRAINING Nevada producers licensed in Fire and Casualty lines who sell National Flood Insurance Policies are required to take a one-time 3-hour course on Flood Insurance.

NONRESIDENT PRODUCERS

Continuing education provisions do not apply to a person who holds: (a) A limited license issued pursuant to NRS 683A.261; or (b) A license as a nonresident producer of insurance or a nonresident insurance consultant.

CE EXEMPTIONS

The following are exempt from Nevada CE requirements:

- Licensees who have 20 years or more of continuous experience in the field of insurance, selling, marketing, underwriting, adjusting, practicing law, managing, regulating, or engaging in any combination of these activities.
- Nonresidents
- Producers holding only limited lines licenses or, CLU, CPCU, ChFC, or CFP.



LICENSE RENEWAL

Producers are encouraged to renew their license via electronic application and submission. Producers may also renew via paper applications. Electronic submissions are generally processed within 5 business days, while paper applications usually require a 4-week review time.

Licensees are encouraged to update their address and e-mail information using the electronic services of Sircon or NIPR.
